



• DRESS IN RIBBON STITCH

YARN
Adriafil yarns

MATERIALS REQUIRED

100g **Avantgarde**, white no. 02. 3 buttons. 65 cms. of pink satin ribbon, height 7 mm. 65 cms. of pink satin ribbon, height 1.5 mm. Needles no. 3. Crochet hook no. 2. Tapestry needle with rounded tip.

AGE: 8/12 months

PATTERNS STITCHES

Chain
Single crochet
Double crochet
Treble crochet

Tight ribbon stitch: work in ribbon stitch following the chart and taking into account that:

o 1 empty square corresponds to: 1 treble in the treble, 1 ch., skip 1 base stitch, 1 treble in the next treble.

o 2 or more empty squares correspond to: * 1 treble in the treble, 1 ch., skip 1 base stitch *, rep. from * to *; bind off the last square with 1 treble in the next treble.

o 1 solid square corresponds to: 1 treble in the treble, 1 treble in the next st. or chain, 1 treble in the next treble.

o 2 or more solid squares correspond to: * 1 treble in the treble, 1 treble in the next st. or chain *, rep. from * to *; Bind off the last square with 1 treble in the next treble.

GAUGE

10 x 10 cm. with the crochet hook no. 2 in ribbon stitch = 17 squares and 14 rows.

WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

Right back, Front and left back: Work in a single piece. With the crochet hook, cast on a chain of 235 sts. and, starting from the 8th chain on the hook, for the skirt, work in narrow ribbon stitch following diagram A. Now, work over all the sts. 2 rows in double crochet halving the sts. in row 1; now work in 1 row as follows: 1 dc., 2 crossed trs. (= skip 1 st., 1 dc., work 1 dc. in the skipped st.) for all the row and end with 1 dc. in the last treble; work another row in dc. Cont. for the body following diagrams B, C and D completing the left back, front and right back separately. Break off and bind the yarn.

FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams. For the wings, work in the rows along the armholes, with exception of the first 3 rows of the front and back body, as follows:

Row 1: * 1 dc. at the top of 1 edge dc., 5 chs., skip the column formed by the edge tr. *, rep. from * to * and bind off the row with 1 dc. at the base of the last treble.

Row 2: * 5 chs., 1 dc. in the next loop *, rep. from * to *, 2 chs., 1 dc. in the last loop.

From rows 3 to 7 rep. row 2.

Without breaking off the yarn, finish with 1 row in double crochet the part of the armhole still free (= cont. in double crochet along the 3 rows skipped in previously, both on the back and front and along the skipped edge of the skirt).

Finish off the neckline, the sides of the back opening and the front bottom and back as follows:

Rows 1 and 2: in double crochet.

Row 3: 1 dc., * 3 chs., skip 1 st., 2 dcs. *, rep. from * to *, 3 chs., skip 1 st., 1 dc.

Break off and bind the yarn.

Braid the satin ribbon (height 7 mm) in the row worked in crossed trebles, at the waist; stop at the ends with small stitches. With the remaining ribbon decorate in the same way the beg. of the wings. With the 1.5 cm. ribbon, make a double bow and fix it at the middle of the front waistband. Sew the buttons on the buttoning side of the back body; use the squares worked in ribbon stitch on the opposite side to make the buttonholes.

• BONNET

YARN
Adriafil yarns

MATERIALS REQUIRED

50g **Avantgarde** col. white no. 02. Cotton **Uno A Ritorto 5** for the embroidery, pink no. 04. 90 cms. of 7 mm pink satin ribbon. 90 cms. of 1.5 mm pink satin ribbon. Needles no. 3. Crochet hook no. 2. Tapestry needle with rounded tip.

PATTERNS STITCHES

Stock stitch
Rib stitch 1/2: k1, p2, in columns.

GAUGE

10 x 10 cm. with needles no. 3 in knit st. = 27 sts. and 42 rows

WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

With needles no. 3, cast on 27 sts. and, for the back, work in stock st. for a length of 10,5 cms.; bind off the stitches in the same way. Cast on 99 sts. and, for the front, work in rib stitch 1/2 for a length of 8,5 cms.; bind off the stitches.

FINISHING

Sew in front around the three sides of back, When work measures 0,5 cm. from the edge. With the crochet hook finish all the outer edges of the bonnet as follows:

Rows 1 and 2: in double crochet.

Row 3: * 2 dcs., 5 chns., skip 1 base st. *, rep. from * to *; Bind off the row with 1 sc. in the first st.

Now finish, only the front edge as follows: * 1 dc. in the next loop, 5 chns. *, rep. from * to *.

Break off and bind the yarn.

Finish the three sides of the back as follows:

Row 1: * 1 dc., 5 chns., skip 2 base sts. *, rep. from * to *, 1 dc.

Break off and bind the yarn.

Embroider 11 flowers in puff stitch at 1 cm. from the edge of the front.

Trim the back with the satin ribbon (8 sts) folding it, as you work, so as to shape the curls.

Cut the satin ribbon (1.5 mm) in two equal lengths and fix each at the ends of the bonnet with a double bow.

• BOOTIES

YARN
Adriafil yarns

MATERIALS REQUIRED (per each bootie)

20g **Avantgarde**, white no. 02. 60 cms. of pink satin ribbon, height 7 mm. Needles no. 3. Crochet hook no. 2. Tapestry needle with rounded tip.

PATTERNS STITCHES

Garner stitch
Stock stitch
Rib stitch 1/2: k1, p2, in columns.
Double crochet

GAUGE

10 x 10 cm. with needles no. 3 in knit st. = 27 sts. and 42 rows

WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

With needles no. 3, cast on 33 sts. and work in garter stitch for a length of 3 cms. increasing at sides of the middle stitch and at the two outer sides, 1 st. every 2 rows 6 times. Cont. in knit st. for a length of 1,5 cms., then, for the middle section of the sole, cont. only on the 15 middle sts. e stand off side stitches. Work in stock st. picking up, at sides, 1 st. every 2 rows 6 times. Cont. over all the sts. in knit st. for a length of 1 cm., then , work 1 row as follows: * k3, * knit 2 tog., 1yo, k2 *, rep. from * to *. Cont. in knit st. for another 1 cm, then, end in rib stitch 1/2. When work measures 4 cms. from the rub stitch edge, and bind off all the sts..

FINISHING

Sew on the sole; Sew the back seams of the booties remembering that you will have to fold this. Braid the satin ribbon on the needle in loops. Make a bow on the middle of the front.

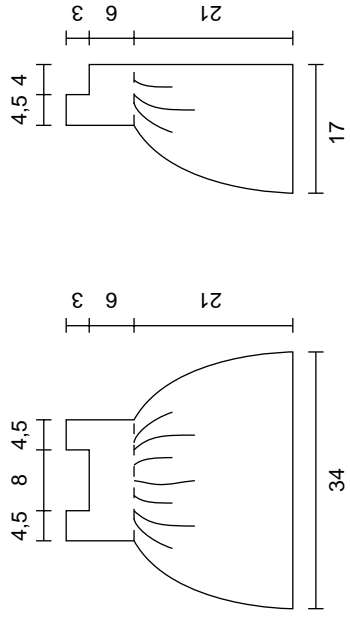
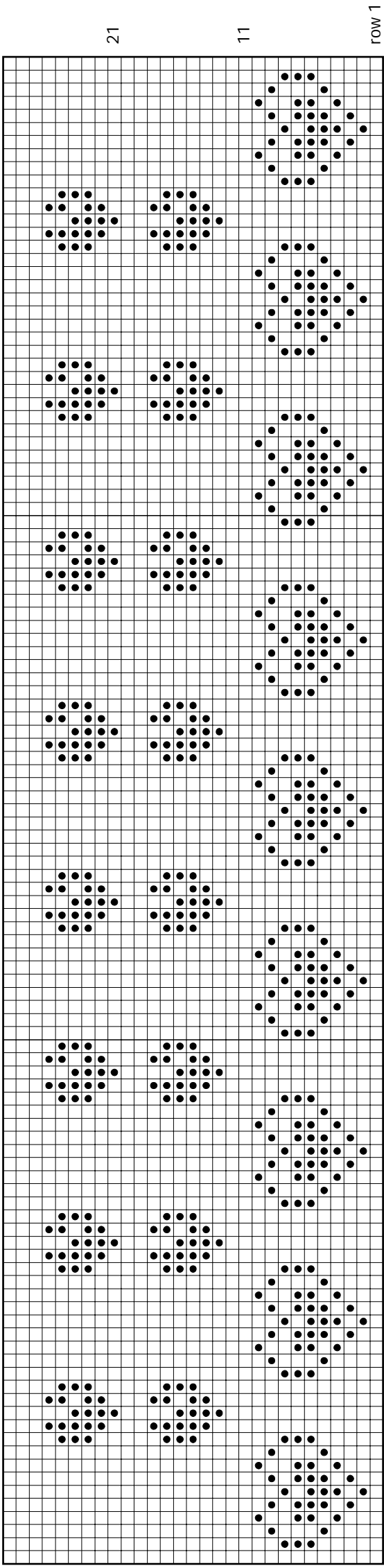


Chart D - back right

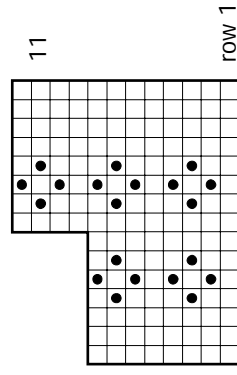


Chart C - front

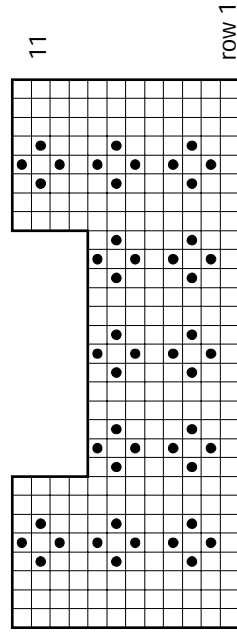
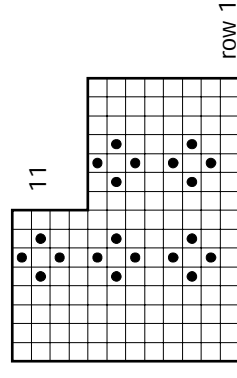


Chart B - back left



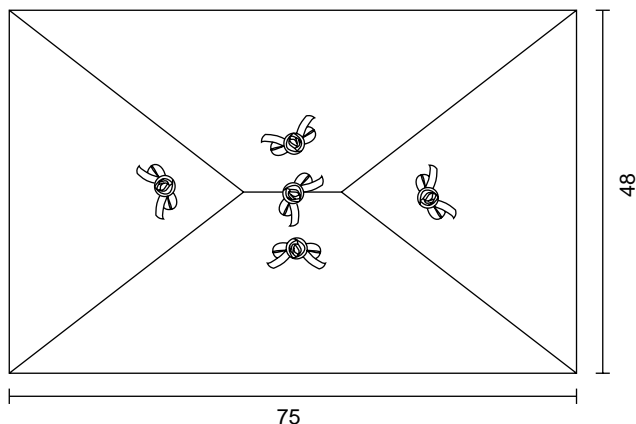


YARN
Adriafile yarns

MATERIALS REQUIRED
250g Nice Baby, pink no. 03.
Embroidery cotton Memphis white no. 02.
Needles no. 3. Crochet hook no. 2.50.
350 cms. Of white satin ribbon, height 7

*, rep. from * to * for the entire row.
Row 4: work like row 3.
Row 5: * 5 trs. in the corner space, ** 1 dc. in the next tr., 2 trs. in the next space **, rep. from ** to ** for the entire side, 1 dc. in the next tr. *, rep. from * to * for the entire row.
Row 6: * 1 dc. in the 1st of the 5 corner trs., 1 popcorn, 3 dcs., 1 popcorn, 1 dc. in the 5th tr.; ** 4 dc., 1 popcorn **, rep. from ** to ** for the entire side, 1 dc. *, rep. from * to * for the entire row.
Break off and bind the yarn.

Cut the satin ribbon into 4 equal lengths of 100 cms and 75 cms in twos; braid in each section into the second row of empty space of the lace edge, starting and ending in the corner space. Bind off the ribbons together tying into a bow in each corner. Sew on the roses at the middle as shown in the picture.

DIMENSIONS: 48x75 cms.

PATTERNS STITCHES

Stock stitch
Chain
Single crochet
Double crochet
Treble crochet
Popcorn: 3 chs., 1 sc. in the 1st chain.

□ = in knit stitch in pink
■ = in knit stitch in white
Each square corresponds 1 st. and 2 rows

GAUGE

10 x 10 cm. with needles no. 3 in knit st. = 33 sts. and 47 rows.

WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

With needles no. 3 cast on 159 sts. and work in stock st. When work measures 75 cms., bind off all the sts.

FINISHING

Embroider the blanket in knit stitch following the diagram (corresponding to 1/4 of the pattern); turn over, along the broken vertical line to make the first half, then, complete the other half of the embroidery to match the first. Finish the edges with the crochet hook yarn worked double as follows:

Row 1: (start from a corner) work in double crochet working in 3 sts. at each corner; bind off this row and all the next rows with 1 sc. in the first st.

Row 2: * in the corner st. work 1 dc. (= replace the 1st tr. of each row with 3 chs.), 2 chs. and 1 dc.; ** 2 chs., skip 2 base sts., 1 dc. **, rep. from ** to ** for the entire side, 2 chs., skip 2 base sts. *, rep. from * to * for the entire row.

Row 3: * in the corner space, work 1 dc., 2 chs. and 1 dc.; 3 chs., ** skip the next tr., 1 dc. in the next space, 2 chs. **, rep. from ** to ** for the entire side, skip the next tr., 1 dc. in the next space, 3 chs.
